
Our **12,000 tutors** are bright inspiring role models studying at top universities. Only **1 in 7** applicants are selected and all are **personally interviewed**.

What steps are taken to keep MyTutor safe?



Verified: Every tutor is personally interviewed, has their ID verified and holds an enhanced DBS certificate.



Private: All communication takes place on our platform and no personal details are shared.



Recorded: All lessons are recorded and can be watched for up to a month.

How to help your child get the most out of their lessons:

- ✓ **Engage** with your child - ask them when their lessons are taking place and what their tutor is like.
- ✓ **Remind** them to attend their lessons. If they miss more than 2 lessons in a row without good reason, they may be replaced by another pupil.
- ✓ **Encourage** your child to come prepared to lessons with topics they might like to focus on
